To be the guiding light for sustainable management practices through undertaking the following activities:



India proudly and fervently commemorates Republic Day on January 26 of each year. It is the anniversary of our constitution's adoption. Almost three years after gaining our independence, on January 26, 1950, India got established as a sovereign, secular, socialist, and democratic republic.

On Republic Day, 21 gun salutes are given to the President of the country. 21 cannons are fired with a gap of 2.25 seconds. The gun salute covers the 52 seconds of the National Anthem in three successive rounds of 7 cannons each. This year, the 21 Gun Salute was indigenously made 105 mm Indian Field Guns (IFGs). The ammunition has also been produced indigenously.

With the same passion, XIDAS came together and celebrated the Anniversary of our Constitutions Adoption. The Program began with speeches, slogan narration and cultural program was the icing on the cake, where the students performed on the rich cultural heritage of India by showcasing different states.








## **Get Together and Work Together**
